

How To Use Eclipse With Graph:

1. Install Graph using `cs016_install graph`.
2. Open Eclipse and create a new project. (File -> New -> Project)
3. Select "Java Project" and click Next.
4. Give your project a name (probably "Graph")
5. Select "Create Project From Existing Source" and select the graph folder in your cs016 directory.
6. Click Next.
7. Click on the Libraries tab and the select "Add External Jar".
8. Locate `graph.jar` in the `/course/cs016/lib` directory and `nds4.jar` in `/course/cs016/lib/nds4` and add them.
9. Click Finish.
10. Create a new package in your project named "graph".
11. Move all 3 java files from "default package" to the graph package.
12. Right click on `MyGraph.java`, go to "Run As" and Select "Run...".
13. Double click on "Java Application" to create a new Run Configuration and name it Graph.
14. "Project" should already say "Graph". If it doesn't, click "Browse" and select it.
15. Fill in "Main Class" with "support.graph.GraphViz "
16. Click on the "Arguments" tab.
17. In the "Program Arguments" box type "graph.MyGraph graph.MyKruskal graph.MyPrimJarnik"
18. Click Run. The Visualizer should now open. Enjoy!
